

CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER YANN GAUTHIER, MMM, CD

Born in Matane, Quebec, Chief Warrant Officer (CWO) Yann Gauthier began his career in the medical field by working as a paramedic serving the population of his hometown. This experience led him to join the Canadian Armed Forces in [January 2005](#) as a Medical Technician.

Après avoir gradué de son NQ3 à l' École du Service de santé des Forces canadiennes à Borden, Ontario, il a été affecté à la 5e Ambulance de campagne à Valcartier, Québec, où il a été déployé en Afghanistan, en tant que soldat, dans le cadre de l'Opération Athéna, Roto 4, en 2007 et une deuxième fois, en tant que caporal, en 2009 (Op Athéna, Roto 7).

In 2010, he was transferred to 25 Canadian Forces Health Services Centre in Bagotville, Quebec where he deployed, for a third time, to Afghanistan in 2011 (Op Athena, Roto 10). During this posting with the Royal Canadian Air Force, he was promoted to Master Corporal and completed his Forward Aeromedical Evacuation Specialist course.

Son service militaire l'a ramené à la 5e Ambulance de campagne en 2012. Tout au long de cette période, il a été promu sergent et attaché au 3e bataillon du Royal 22e Régiment, où il a obtenu sa qualification de base de parachutiste et a été déployé en Ukraine dans le cadre de l'Opération Unifier, Roto 1, en 2016.

Upon his promotion to warrant officer in 2017, he was posted to 41 Canadian Forces Health Services Centre Detachment Longue-Pointe in Montreal, Quebec to work with the local Canadian Forces Recruiting Centre.

Promu au grade d'adjudant-maître (Adjum) en 2019, il a été affecté au Direction général carrières militaires à Ottawa, Ontario, où il a agi successivement en tant que Gestionnaire de carrière des techniciens médicaux junior et comme Gestionnaire de carrière des militaires du rang des Services de santé.

With the love and support his spouse WO Karine Rousselle and his daughter Maély, CWO Gauthier was promoted to his current rank in [June 2022](#) and was appointed as the School Chief Warrant Officer of the Canadian Force Health Services Training Centre in Borden, Ontario.
